



Swearing-in of Judge Alexander Wolf

On December 7, 2015, Judge Alexander Wolf was sworn in as a Provincial Court Judge at the Office of the Chief Judge. Following orientation Judge Wolf is assigned to the OCJ Region.

Judge Wolf has legal experience in Canada, India, the Philippines and Fiji. Since receiving his law degree from Dalhousie University in 1993, he has been called to the bar in Ontario, Yukon, Northwest Territories, B.C. and Fiji. Mr. Wolf has gained expertise as a Crown Prosecutor, defence counsel, poverty lawyer, legal aid lawyer and sole practitioner. His legal career includes residential school cases for the Justice Department and management of the Vancouver Aboriginal Law Centre, which deals with Aboriginal, family and poverty law issues. Since 2004, he has concentrated on his private practice in North Vancouver.
