### **CONDOLENCES - THE HONOURABLE JUDGE ANNE WALLACE**

The Provincial Court of British Columbia announces with great sadness that the Honourable Judge Anne Wallace passed away yesterday in Kelowna, British Columbia.

Following articles in Victoria, British Columbia, Judge Wallace was engaged in private practice in Vancouver and Victoria. Judge Wallace joined the Crown Counsel office in Victoria in 1994 and remained with the Crown office until her appointment to the Court. In December 2003 she was appointed Queen's Counsel. Judge Wallace was appointed a Judge of the Provincial Court of British Columbia on August 29, 2005, and assigned to Kelowna, British Columbia, where she had presided since then.

Judge Wallace served the Court and the people of British Columbia with great compassion, dedication and distinction. She contributed in many ways to the life of the Court with her bright and engaging personality and ever enduring sense of optimism. She continues to serve as an inspiration to us all.
