Downtown Community Court evaluation released

VICTORIA – The Ministry of Justice has released the final evaluation of the Downtown Community Court (DCC).

The DCC is the first of its kind in Canada, offering an innovative court model that has the objective of bringing together multiple agencies to address the health and social needs of offenders, reducing recidivism, improving court efficiencies and engaging with the community.

The evaluation of the DCC consists of three studies focused on:

- Offender outcomes (recidivism).
- Court efficiency.
- Community engagement.

The recidivism study has undergone an academic peer review to validate its findings. It has been published by PLOS ONE, an online scientific journal for peer-reviewed research, published by the Public Library of Science.

The DCC evaluation will inform the development of a broader strategy for specialized courts in British Columbia, which is scheduled for completion in March 2015.
