PRACTICE DIRECTION

CFCSA CONSENT REQUISITIONS

Purpose

To set out the procedure for adjourning matters under the *Child, Family and Community Service Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 46 (CFCSA) where all parties consent.

Application

This practice direction applies to all court registries in the Province.

Direction

1. Effective March 27, 2020 until further direction, Director's counsel may file a <u>Consent Requisition Form</u> to adjourn CFCSA matters upon obtaining the written consent of all parties.
