Appointment of Judge to the Provincial Court of British Columbia

It is my great pleasure and privilege to announce that the Lieutenant Governor in Council has signed an Order in Council appointing Clarke Burnett to the Court as a full time judge.

Judge Burnett – will be sworn in on February 25, 2019. He will be assigned to the Interior Region with Chambers in Kelowna.

Judge Burnett graduated from the University of British Columbia with an LL.B in 1991 and joined Kelowna firm Pushor Mitchell as an associate the following year. His early practice focused on civil and personal injury litigation. In 1995, he expanded his practice to include both criminal defense and prosecution work as an agent for the Department of Justice, now called the Public Prosecution Service of Canada (PPSC). The majority of his practice has been criminal defense and prosecution work for the PPSC
