

- iii. Each party must meet the early resolution requirements as set out in the [Provincial Court \(Family\) Rules](#) Appendix B, Part 2.

b. Expedited Court Process

- i. If, after having met the early resolution requirements, a court proceeding is required to change the support order or agreement, the party must submit the following documents to PCCM, which can be reached by telephone (604-660-2528 or Toll free 1-866-660-2684) or by email at pccm@gov.bc.ca, and serve a copy on each other party of the following documents found under “Early Resolution and Case Management Registry Forms (only in the Victoria court registry)”:
- [Family Law Matter Claim](#) (Form C) with Schedule 4 and/or Schedule 10;
 - [Financial Statement](#) (Form D); and
 - [Financial Statement Addendum](#).
- ii. FMEP clients must also provide a copy of the documents to their enforcement officer as required by the *Family Maintenance Enforcement Act*.
