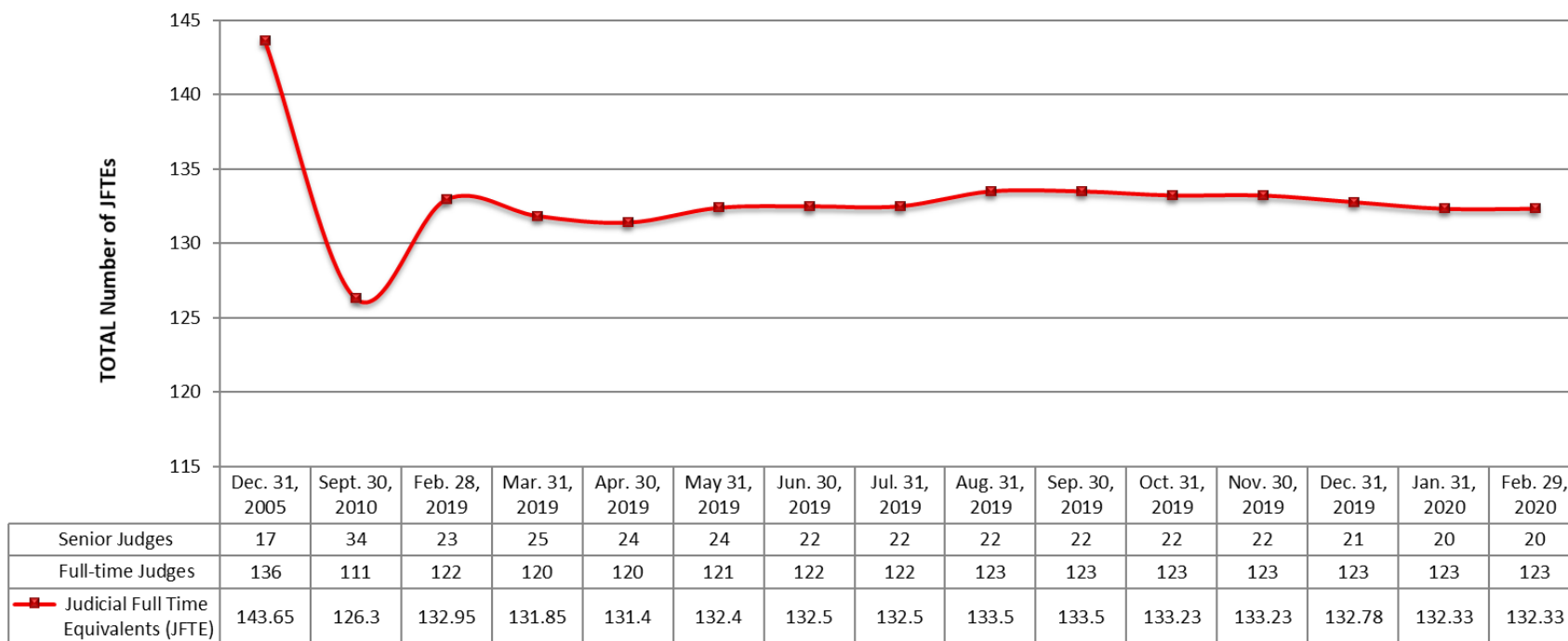

The red line in the table below shows judicial complement over time. The first value is the December 2005 value used as a baseline in the original Justice Delayed Report; the second value is the complement as at the date of the report (September 30, 2010). The rest of the values are as at the end of each month over the past year. These values are displayed as FTEs and include part time judges.

<sup>i</sup> The complement number shown here reflects the JFTE as of the first day of the next month. The retirement of a judge, election of a judge to senior status, or the return of a judge previously on LTD to sitting status on the first day of a month is recorded as of the last day of the previous month. The last sitting day of a retiring senior judge is recorded as a retirement as of the last day of the month in which that occurred.

<sup>ii</sup> JFTE = Judicial Full Time Equivalent positions. This includes all full time judge positions (1 JFTE) + all senior judge positions (0.45 JFTE) province wide. This total does not include the equivalent of 4.67 FTEs currently on full or partial Long Term Disability.
